

## Hebrews 5:1

- 1) God has made a **provision**.
  - a) The high priest had the position to help in time of **need** and time of **blessing**.

## Hebrews 5:2

- 2) The reason that they could go to the high priest is that he was **one** of them.

## Hebrews 5:3

- 3) The high priest wasn't **better** than the ones that he served.
  - a) The Christian Jews were thinking of returning to the old sacrificial system to avoid persecution, and have an easier life.
  - b) Who would you rather have **representing** you, a sinful man or the living God?
  - c) How many Christians today have left following **Christ** to follow a **man**?

## Hebrews 5:4

- 4) Why is he qualified? Why should they listen to him?
  - a) Because he is **called** by God.

## Hebrews 5:5,6

5) This is speaking of Christ's position as our high priest after the **resurrection**.

## Hebrews 5:7-9

- 6) We are **expected** to learn obedience the same way that Christ did.
- 7) Learning obedience is **following** the Word of God, by the power of the Spirit of God, to **accomplish** the will of God.

## Hebrews 5:10

8) After dying for our sins, Christ is now our **High Priest**.
