

## Hebrews 6:11,12

- 1) Follow the examples of others.
  - a) **Look** at their example.
    - i. What were their circumstances and their situations?
  - b) **Learn** from their example.
    - i. How did God show himself faithful?
  - c) **Let** God's word have preeminence in your life.
    - i. Are you submitting yourself to his word.

## Hebrews 6:13-15

- 2) Abraham, an example of **obtaining** the promise.
- 3) When did Abraham obtain the promise?
  - a) Abraham obtains the promise when he stopped **doing** what he thought was best and **trusted** God's Word above all things.
- 4) "patiently endured" means to be **longsuffering**.

## Hebrews 6:16-18

- 5) God desires all believers to trust his **unchanging** word above all things.
- 6) Because of who God is and what he has promised we should have **comfort** and a confident expectation that God will **accomplish** his purpose.
  - a) God's faithfulness produces **hope**.

## Hebrews 6:19,20

- 7) Our anchor is our **confidence** in Christ.
  - a) Anchors keep us in **place**.
- 8) A forerunner means that he has gone **ahead** of us.
  - a) We will be **with** him one day.
