- i) This was God's **deliberate** plan to limit the information about Melchisedec so that he could use him as an example.
- j) He was **continually** fulfilling the office of priest, doing the priestly duties.

2) Facts and observations

- a) The type; First King of righteousness
- b) The anti type; the first coming of Christ when he **provided** righteousness through his death, burial, and resurrection.
- c) The type; King of Salem which is King of peace
- d) The antitype; the second coming of Christ where he will **rule** from Jerusalem.

Hebrews 7:1-3

2) Facts and observations

- e) The type; we do not know his origins, his beginning or end.
- f) The antitype; Christ is **eternal**; he has no beginning or end.
- g) Melchisedec compared to the Levitical priesthood where one's genealogy is everything.
- h) We have no right to the Levitical priesthood, but we can **serve** in the priesthood of Melchisedec because it is not dependent upon our genealogy.

- 5) Levi was commanded even though they were **equal** to their brothers.
- 6) Levi **inherited** the priesthood but Melchisedec didn't.
- 7) Melchisedec is **greater** than Abraham because Abraham gave tithes to him.
- 8) Melchisedec's **priesthood** has no end.
- 9) The doctrine of federal headship is **demonstrated** with Levi, Abraham, and Melchisedec.
