- 4) This is God's **plan**.
- 5) The priests,
 - a) The purpose for them going into the Holy Place was to do the **service** of God.

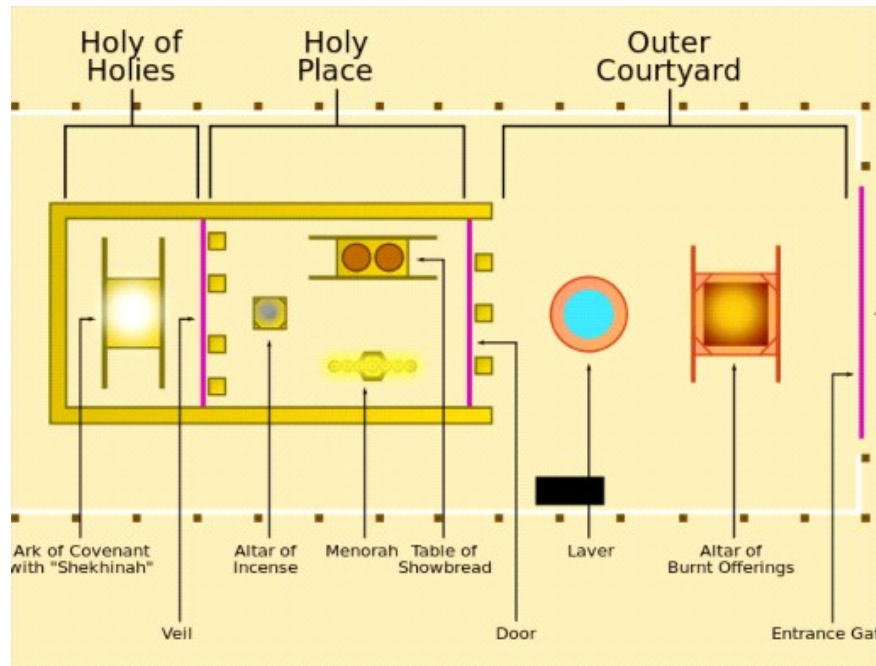
Hebrews 9:6,7 What the priests duties

6) The High Priest

- a) Who? Only the high priest could go into the Holy of Holies.
- b) When? Only **once** a year during the Day of Atonement
- c) How? Only with **blood**.
- d) Why? For his sins and the sins of the nation Israel.

- 7) The **way** into the presence of God was not made then, but **now** it is.



Hebrews 9:8-10 The Interpretation

- 8) God is **inviting** saved men to come into his presence and have fellowship with him.
- 9) Christ **provided** the way for sinful man to be in the presence of God.
- 10) The purpose for us going into his presence is to do the **service** of God.
