

## Hebrews 10:1-4 The Problem

- 1) The shadows, the law and sacrifices, could not **perfect** or **purge** anyone.
- 2) It is **impossible** for shadows to accomplish God's will.

## Hebrews 10:5-9 The Solution

- 3) Jesus left heaven to **accomplish** the will of the Father.
- 4) God is not interested in shadows because they cannot **accomplish** his will.
- 5) God prepared a body; this is what was required for Jesus to **accomplish** the will of God.

## Hebrews 10:5-9 The Solution

- 6) The Law could only **convict** people of sin.
- 7) The sacrifices only **demonstrated** that people needed a **substitute** for sin.
  - a) They were both shadows that had absolutely no strength to **deliver** a person from sin's penalty.

## Hebrews 10:10-14 The Equipping

- 8) He has **prepared** you.
- 9) He has **equipped** you.
- 10) Once for all.
  - a) One sacrifice for all **sins**.
  - b) One sacrifice for all **people**.
- 11) You are set apart and equipped to **accomplish** the will of the Father.

## Hebrews 9:15-17 The Proof

12) Once a debt is paid, you don't **continue** to make another payment.

## Hebrews 10:19-25 The Instructions

13) Enter in to that **fellowship** with God.

14) Identify yourself with Christ your **sacrifice** and die to self and **submit** yourself to the will of the Father.
